

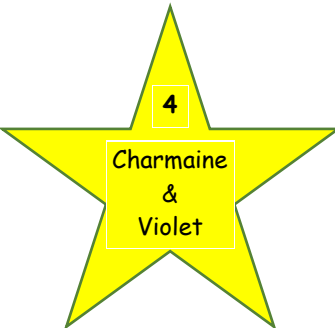
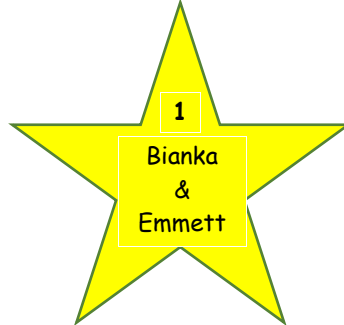

10 minutes late = 6.5 days learning lost

15 minutes late = 10 days learning lost
