



## **Keeping Our Children Safe at Drop Off and Pick Up Times**

We would like to remind all parents and carers about the importance of observing the parking restriction on the road outside the school, bus stop and surrounding area.

These parking restrictions are in place to protect children during the busiest and most vulnerable times of the school day.

When vehicles not adhering to best practise when by the school, it can create serious safety risks, including:

- Children crossing the road unexpectedly, often distracted or rushing
- Reduced visibility due to buses, parked vehicles, and blind spots
- Increased congestion in a narrow space, raising the risk of collisions
- Obstruction of buses, which can force children to walk around moving traffic

Children may not always judge speed or distance accurately, and the presence of extra vehicles significantly increases the chance of accidents or near misses.

We kindly ask parents and carers to:

- Respect all aspects of road safety, especially when by a school
- Use nearby car parks
- Park safely and legally
- Set an example to their children

These measures are not about inconvenience — they are about ensuring that every child arrives at and leaves school safely.
