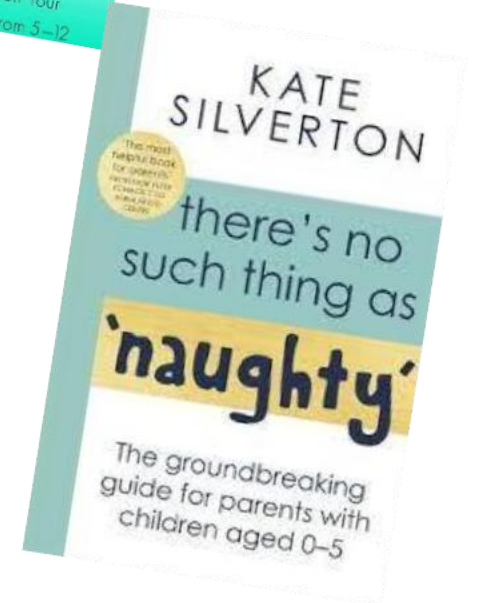
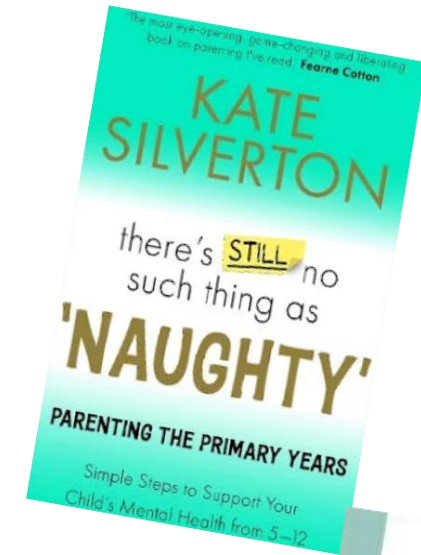
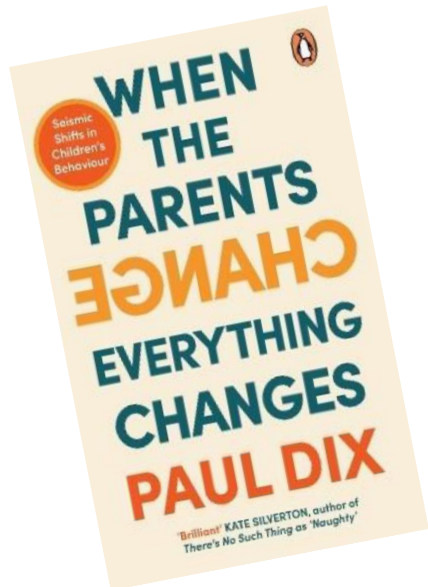
Introduction
